

IV. The Conclusion of the Millennial Kingdom (Rev 20:7-10)

When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison, 8 and will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together for the war; the number of them is like the sand of the seashore. 9 And

they came up on the broad plain of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city, and fire came down from heaven and devoured them. 10 And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are also; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever (Rev 20:7-10).

C. The Sentence of Satan (v. 10)

1. The Fiery Destination of Satan (v. 10a)

And the devil who deceived them was thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone

2. The Defeated Allies of Satan (v. 10b)

where the beast and the false prophet are also

3. The Eternal Torment of Satan (v. 10c)

and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever

THE FINAL JUDGMENT OF UNBELIEVERS: THE GREAT WHITE THRONE

KEY PASSAGE: Revelation 20:11-15 *And I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. 12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books according to their deeds. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds. 14 And death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. 15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.*

A. The Inescapable Judge (v. 11)

11 And I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them.

B. The Incontestable Trial (vv. 12-13)

12 And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books according to their deeds. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds.

C. The Irreversible Sentence (vv. 14-15)

14 And death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. 15 And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

CONCLUSION:

- In light of the coming terrors of hell, consider a few questions:
 - Am I living a secret life of sin? If so, will eternity in hell be worth it?
 - Is there any sin in my life worth holding onto?
 - Have I come all the way to Christ? Or will I go to hell “almost saved”?
 - Have I repented and surrendered in faith to Christ?
 - How good is God to send Christ as my hell-bearing substitute?
